

Spectator Guidelines For Golf Championships

1. Please feel free to ask for a tournament pairing sheet in the Pro Shop
2. The uses of motorized golf carts are **NOT PERMITTED.**
3. Parents, relatives, and friends are permitted to walk around with the competitors. (In the rough and away from the tee.) There will be **NO COMMUNICATION.**
4. There will be **NO COACHING** of the competitors by coaches or spectators during the round of play. Any player communicating with or receiving coaching may be penalized 2 strokes or disqualified from the tournament.
5. Keep cheering positive. There should be no profanity or degrading language or gestures.
6. Show appreciation of good play by all competitors.
7. Learn the rules of the game in order to be a better-informed spectator.
8. Encourage other spectators to participate in the spirit of good sportsmanship.
9. Accept the judgment of tournament officials.
10. Treat all competitors in a manner in which you would expect to be treated.
11. During inclement weather when the siren sounds, spectators should take precautions such as:
 - a. Move toward parking lots.
 - b. Seek shelters.

In all circumstances avoid the following:

- Open areas
- Hilltops and high places
- Isolated trees
- Golf carts
- Wire fences
